Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must be:

- Current high school seniors attending school in Montana and a resident of Montana.
- Anticipating completion of high school diploma at the time of application.
- Planning to pursue a degree in art education, fine arts, graphic arts and design or architecture at an accredited U.S. post-secondary institution.
- May use scholarship money for workshops and art seminars from a professional artist.
- Approval by the Young Masters Scholarship Program may be required.
- Scholarship will be awarded up to \$2500 for post-secondary education.
- Scholarship for workshops and seminars will be awarded in varying amounts.

Selection

A diverse committee associated with the Young Masters Art Education Program will select the scholarship winners. Applicants will be notified of the results prior the annual Out West Art Show in March.

Scholarships are restricted to tuition and fees and supplies and will be paid directly to accredited schools

The Young Masters Scholarship Program application deadline for post secondary is February 1 at 5:00pm, and study will commence in the fall.

- Submit your resume.
- Include 6-10 photos of students artwork
- List student shows entered and awards won.
- List art projects you have participated in.
- List participation in community art projects
- Include docent or volunteer work done at a museum or art show.
- Include work done at a gallery or frame shop.
- Include participation in activities related to the applicant's field of study

Describe how the scholarship money will be used.

Include 2 letters of recommendation. One letter should be from your art teacher.
